Scholarship **Recipient** Instructions

** All scholarship funds will be **paid directly to the institution** on behalf of the student by the Sweetwater Woman's Club after official verification of enrollment has been received. It is the recipient's responsibility to complete this process in a timely manner so that funds can be received by the institution on schedule.*

In order to claim your scholarship we **must** have this information:

1. **Your student ID number at the school receiving your scholarship.** Without this information the school won't know in which account to deposit the scholarship money.
2. Copy of official verification of enrollment as a full time student (12 units or more).
3. **The address of the school and name of the office on campus where the check needs to go.** Without this information your scholarship check will get lost on campus.
4. How the receiving school wants the check made out.
