

Sweetwater Woman's Club Scholarship Overview and Instructions

- * Applicant must have sufficient grade point average (GPA) to be admitted to a college, community college, or trade school.
- * Applicant must attest to a financial need.
- * Twelve graduating seniors (or returning winners) will be awarded \$1,500 each for the 2020-2021 academic year.(see lines 4 & 5 below)
- * Scholarship applications for 2020-2021 must be received by the Sweetwater Woman's Club at the address below by April 10, 2020. **No late applications accepted.**

Scholarship recipient instructions

****All scholarship funds will be paid directly to the institution on behalf of the student by the Sweetwater Woman's Club after official verification of enrollment has been received. It is the recipient's responsibility to complete this process in a timely manner so that funds can be received by the institution on schedule.***

*In order to process your scholarship in a timely manner we **must** have this information:

1. Your student ID number at the school receiving your scholarship
2. Official verification of enrollment as a full time student (12 units or more) this means an official document on the letterhead stationary of the institution of enrollment, signed by an official and completed with a seal of the institution
3. The address of the school and name of the office on campus where the check needs to go.

*The scholarship awarded to the student must be used no later than the second semester/quarter of 2020-2021.

* Each recipient will be eligible to re-apply consecutively for no more than three more years, however, additional scholarships are not guaranteed.

* If a recipient applies for a scholarship for the next consecutive year, she or he must submit a transcript of the past year's units demonstrating a minimum GPA of 2.7. A new application must be filled out following the same guidelines as before.

* Due to budgetary considerations, succeeding awards may be raised or lowered at the Scholarship Committee's discretion
